




Framing the Narrative: Photographs from the Permanent Collection

Lesson Plan:

David Bates's Magnolia and Lemon

This lesson plan contains the Texas TEKS for Elementary, Middle, and High School art teachers. Students will learn about David Bates' use of abstraction, Modernism, and still life in his composition *Magnolia and Lemon*. Afterwards, the students will create Styrofoam prints of a composed still life. Then, the prints will be painted using watercolors.

2022 Day of the Dead Art Exhibition

The Day of the Dead Middle School Art Exhibition is an annual event held at the TMA. Students between the grade levels of 5th grade – 8th grade are eligible to create artworks in their classrooms that celebrate the cultural festivities of *Día de los Muertos*.

The exhibition is free and currently open to the public until November 6, 2022. The museum will hold a reception for the event on November 5, 2022 at 2:00pm. All students, families, and teachers are invited to the art reception.

This year, 22 schools, 29 teachers, and a total of 680 students in the East Texas area participated in the *2022 Middle School Day of the Dead Exhibition*.
